

SCHOOL OF MEDICAL SCIENCES HONOURS APPLICATION FORM

The School of Medical Sciences offers Honours full-time (SOMS4001) and part-time (SOMS4002) courses. For entry into each Honours course, a Science* student must complete at least 18 units at Level III in the relevant Major sequence outlined for each discipline in SoMS (see the UNSW Online Handbook for prerequisites for Majors/Specialisations in Anatomy, Exercise Physiology, Pathology, Pharmacology, and Physiology). Exceptions to these requirements will only be permitted with the consent of the Honours Coordinator (e.g. for Majors outside of the above mentioned SoMS disciplines).

A credit average ($\geq 65\%$ weight average mark; WAM) for all pre-Honours courses, a credit average for all Level III courses relevant to the Major sequence, and completion of General Education requirements (12 units in total with no units being undertaken in the Science or Medicine faculties) are also required by both Science and Medical Science students prior to entry into the Honours program. An applicant with a WAM of 60 to 64 will only be considered if the weighted average for all of their Level III subjects is $\geq 65\%$. There are no other exceptions to this requirement.

The following form should be completed by the candidate and submitted to the Student Enquiries Counter, BSB Student Office (G27), Ground Floor, Biological Sciences Building.

Honours applications for S1-2012 are due by 4th of November 2011.
