Refugee Soccer Development Program

What we are



This innovative program assists young refugees and their families in their immigration and integration to New South Wales, with capacity building, empowerment, through a soccer development program. The program uses their passion for football as its vehicle.

What does Football United do?

The program provides opportunities to refugee youth: gala days, vacation camps, football training after school and on weekends, training opportunities, linking to clubs, coaching, refereeing, sports management courses.

The key aim of the program is to address problems that arise out of social inequity and social exclusion.

You can help!

If you can help out with volunteer time, equipment, or financial sponsorship, or know someone who can, get in touch. We'd love to meet you.

Examples of donations and where they can go :

** in-kind donations of gear, IT , HR support

\$50 provides needed gear to kids who don't have any

\$100 can fund a place in coaching course, fund registration to a local club,

\$150 can support a child at soccer holiday camp, fund a place in a referee course

\$500 contributes to funding a community gala day for 60 kids and parents

\$1000 supports a coaching course for ten youth or referee course for 7 youth

\$ 5000 contributes to a Saturday after school program for 60 youth for 4 months or a 4 day camp for 30 children

\$10 000 supports a Saturday or after school program for 60 youth for ¾ year or contributes to a 4 day soccer camp for 30 youth

\$15 000 supports a Saturday or after school program for 60 kids for one year, or a 4 day residential camp for 30 youth
