eMed is a web-based curriculum management system developed by the Faculty for staff and students in the undergraduate Medicine Program (MED3802/3841). It includes an online curriculum map, a timetable, various assessment related tools, and some administrative tools.

UNSW TELT Gateway

The **UNSW TELT Gateway** brings together the suite of technologies and applications that support learning and teaching at UNSW such as Blackboard, Lectopia, Media Services, Plagiarism detection and Assessment tools etc. It provides the central access point for all the applications currently available on the platform with login links or instructions on how to sign up for each service.

Training resources and support information to help users are also linked to this Gateway.

Blackboard is a learning management system which UNSW will move to in Session 1, 2010.

The undergraduate Medicine course modules in Blackboard will integrate with eMed Map to provide additional learning resources and discussion groups for each course, including a private discussion area for teachers. You may find these systems useful to familiarise yourself with the course content of the UMP and with your own teaching activities within the course.

What should I do to access these systems?

To access eMed and the Library's online resources and other UNSW online services you will need a current UNSW Staff ID Number (log in name) and a UniPass(private password). Information about IT Services at UNSW is available at http://www.it.unsw.edu.au/services/services_home.html - see links to Services for Staff and to Access Forms. You can obtain your UniPass over the phone by contacting the UNSW IT Service Desk on (02) 9385-1333, and answering some identity-verification questions. To access Blackboard you will need to use a Zpass instead of the Unipass, details on setting up a Zpass are at: http://www.it.unsw.edu.au/staff/zpass/create_zpass.html

Once you know your Staff ID and UniPass/Zpass, you will need to arrange access to eMed and any Blackboard course sites for undergraduate Medicine by contacting the Faculty's Map/TeLT Support Staff on (02) 9385-8795, or email Suzanne Mobbs (s.mobbs@unsw.edu.au) or Kerrie Arnhold (kerriea@unsw.edu.au). Full-time, part-time and conjoint staff members automatically get "reader" access to eMed Map, but casual/sessional and contract staff must request access. Staff access to Blackboard is course-specific and available only on request if you are not involved in teaching in the course. For access to other Blackboard courses in SOMS or SPHCM, contact the school's TeLT Administrator.

How do I log into these systems?

Once your access to eMed Map and Blackboard has been arranged, you will need to use your Staff ID Number (username) and UniPass or Zpass (password) to log into these systems. Your staff number must be preceded by a lower case "s" or "z" (or "m" if you have a miscellaneous account).

To log into eMed (use Unipass) go to <http://emed.med.unsw.edu.au> and follow the instructions on the screen.

To log into Blackboard go to the TELT Gateway site at <http://telt.unsw.edu.au/> choose the Learning Management systems section and follow the instructions on the screen to login in to UNSW Blackboard (use Zpass).
