## Publications

- List author(s) and title for any publications.
- What articles are in progress?
- What articles might be begun in the next 6 months? By whom?

## New Researchers

- Are there any new researchers involved in the project? Is their IP situation clear? Has the IP policy been explained to the new researchers?
- Have you discussed IP issues recently?
- Have you discussed authorship issues recently?
- Have you developed anything new?
- Have you been involved in writing during this period?
- Are any IP issues likely to arise in the next 6 months?

## Partnerships or collaborations

- Have you/your group entered into, or are you intending to enter into, a new collaboration or partnership?
- Have there been any major changes to existing collaborations or partnerships?
